## Reading the Text:

- 1. In vv. 17 22, Paul says when the Corinthians get together it's actually "for the worse." What does he mean? What is happening in the church?
- 2. In vv. 23 26, why does Paul play back the experience of the Last Supper?
- 3. To emphasize the gravity of communion, Paul warns them not to participate in communion in "*an unworthy manner*." What would make it "a worthy manner"?
- 4. In vv. 33-34, what is Paul's immediate recommendation for their gathering?

## Knowing the Full Picture:

5. Read Luke 22:14-23. What similarities and differences do you see between Luke's account of the Last Supper, Paul's account in 1 Cor. 11:23-26, and what it had become in the Corinthian church?

## Living It Out:

- 6. What has your overall experience been with communion? Good? Bad? Meaningful? Routine?
- 7. Are there things that we do that would make our participation in communion "unworthy"?
- 8. Are there things that we could do differently or think differently to make our participation in communion more significant to our faith?
