Thanks-giving

- Genesis – Points to One whose heel will crush the serpent's head

Thanks-giving

- The books of the law – Establish a perfect standard – There is One who is the embodiment and fulfilment of the law, who meets its requirements and ends them!

Thanks-giving

- In Joshua, Judges, the Kings and Chronicles – God's people are searching for a righteous, holy king, the perfect leader of God's people who would prepare a land for them and beat back every enemy of their wellbeing

Thanks-giving
