  - Finds Jesus (through John the Baptist)
  - Follows Jesus
  - Tells his brother - “We found the Messiah”
  - Introduces Simon to Jesus

- Simon (Peter) –
  - Brother of Andrew
  - Likely a known person to the audience of John's gospel
    - Andrew is Simon Peter's brother (v.40)
  - Origin story for Peter
  - Jesus knows Peter

# The Story of Jacob/Israel

- Jacob (Genesis 25-33)
  - Steals Esau's birthright, steals Isaac's blessing (deceit)
  - Wrestled with God – name becomes Israel
  - Had a vision of angels ascending and descending and God declaring His faithfulness to His promises
