John 18:1-27

Reading the Text:

1. What are some of the themes/ideas that have come up in recent chapters? What is the immediate context of the passage we are in now?
2. What details (people, places, time, etc.) stand out to you in Jesus' betrayal and arrest [vv. 1-11]? Why do you think John included these details?
3. During the Jewish trial in vv. 19-24, what are the questions being asked? Who is asking them? Why do you think John tells the story this way?
4. What contrast do you see between the ways Jesus and Peter handled adversity?
5. How would you summarize the big idea of this passage?

Living It Out:

1. Do you find it important that Jesus knowingly came forward to take on the wrath of God? What difference would it make if Jesus was less aware/involved in the process?
2. How do you typically handle times of adversity? What principles from this text may help impact your next difficult season? How could you increasingly live these out?
3. As a Life Group, how can we appropriately encourage one another in these times of adversity?
