



Life Group Discussion Questions

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John 2:1-11
For the week of March 27, 2022

Reading the Text:

1. In vv. 3 - 4, what is Mary asking Jesus to do? Is she asking for a miracle to be performed?
2. Why did Jesus choose to use the water from the stone water jars rather than a different source? What in the text helps draw our conclusion?
3. Who are the people that are part of the experience of Jesus' wine in vv. 6 - 11? In what order do they learn about it and what details does each person or group learn?

Knowing the Full Picture:

4. Read Hebrews 2:1-4. In pointing to the "*signs and wonders*" from God, what does the author say about the role these play in our understanding of God and His promise to us?

Living It Out:

5. Is it a challenge to appreciate the physical and spiritual parts of miracles? Why? How can we find an appropriate value for both parts?
6. Do we see Jesus working in our lives, even beyond physical "miracles"? What does examining our lives for His work do for our heads? For our hearts? For how we interact with others?
7. As a group, how can we help each other appropriately look for deeper meanings in familiar Bible stories, especially ones about Jesus' miracles?
