- A Recent Barna Survey Revealed:
 - 62% of teenagers have received a sexual image via their cell phones
 - 3 out of 4 Christian young adults (ages 18-24) are actively looking at pornography on the internet
 - 3 out of 5 divorces cite the use of porn as a major factor which disrupted the relationship
