## Reading the Text:

- 1. What was the big idea for the previous text in 6:10-17?
- 2. What does it mean to "keep alert with all perseverance"? In what context are people often encouraged or required to persevere? How does this relate to the idea of the broader context (as determined in question 1 above)?
- 3. What does it mean that Paul is "an ambassador in chains"? As an ambassador in chains, what is Paul's "prayer request"?
- 4. This paragraph (vv. 10-20) is about how we must rely on God in order to stand. In what way do these verses (vv. 18-20) encourage the need for God and His power?
- 5. How would you state the big idea of Ephesians 6:18-20 in your own words?

## Living It Out:

- 1. As you read this text, where does it impact you, personally? Why?
- 2. The book of Ephesians is one of Paul's "prison epistles", meaning he is writing the letter from prison. How may his request for even greater boldness- while in prison for this very boldness- motivate you to pray and speak with others?
- 3. What role can this Life Group play in encouraging one another to revitalize and refresh our life of prayer?
