- 3. What does Paul's prayer tell us (in vv. 16-19) about what he feels is the greatest need of believers in order to be who God wants them to be?
- 4. What does Paul's prayer (in vv. 20 and 21) teach us about God and about ourselves?
- 5. How would you restate Paul's prayer in your own words?

#### Living It Out:

- 1. What were some of your ongoing prayers to God in 2023?
- 2. How can we go about developing the kind of relationship with God that Paul desires for us in this prayer?
- 3. How can what we do in Life Groups help us build that kind of relationship?
