Good Samaritan

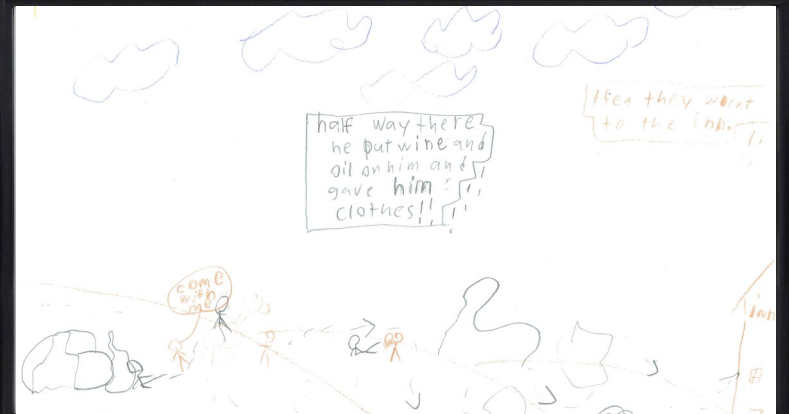
(Luke 15:8-10)

Big Idea: Love Others

Concrete Concepts: Journey, Wound, Compassion

1. Bring it to life (activities):

- (Pre-K-2nd) Provide your child with bandages and a play doctor kit so they can take care of their dolls and stuffed animals. Talk about times they have been sick and been cared for.
- (3rd-6th) Read the story together and make a list of the characters that are in the story. Let your children decide how to act out the story with the family. You may act it out more than ONCE letting the children take turns playing different characters in the story.

(Luke 10:30-37)

2. Pull it apart (conversation):

- Do you remember a time when you were sick or hurt? Who took care of you?
- Do you remember a time when you were hurt by someone else? How did that feel?
- Do you remember a time when you helped someone else that was hurt? How did you feel when you did that?
- Have you ever seen or heard someone be mean to another person at school? What could you do to help them?

3. Model it (for the adults):

- Who is a great example of a neighbor in your life? What have they done to make you feel this way?
- Who are the people you know that could benefit from receiving a little more love from you?
- Who would your children or grandchildren say you are a great neighbor to?
